



## Hardhat Upgrade for Enhanced Site Safety



There is a positive change to the wearing of hard hats requirements later this year. From **August 2026** all Heidelberg Materials sites require any person attending site to wear a safety helmet which includes a fixed 4-point chinstrap.

### The 4-point chin strap helmet is mandatory for all employees and contractors when:

- Entering or exiting vehicles.
- All working at height activities where a person could be injured following a fall
- When a risk assessment identifies the need to do so

For all the above activities the helmet must be worn with the chin strap securely fastened to prevent it coming off in the event of a fall.

**Incidents increase by a third during winter months!**



### Preparation:

#### Before your journey:

- Check weather and Route
- Clear vehicle of snow and ice
- Double check tyres
- Emergency kit
- Topped up fluids
- Brake & lights check

#### During your journey:

- Reduce your speed
- Avoid harsh breaking/accelerating
- Watch for black ice

#### In difficult situation:

- Have a backup plan/point of contact
- Diff lock if required
- Stay warm and rest

## Driver Wellbeing

- 1 in 4 people experience mental health issues
- At any given time 1 in 6 working age adults have symptoms associated with poor mental health
- Mental ill health is responsible for 72 million working days lost in the UK at a cost of £56B a year
- In Britain, someone is made ill by stress every 2 minutes (TUC October 2015)
- Mental Ill-Health is the largest cause of long-term sickness absence (42%), followed by Musculoskeletal System Disorders (13%). (Gov.uk 2022)
- The risk of suicide is 3 x higher in this sector than the national average
- 97% of workers experienced stress in the last year (Chartered Institute of Building 2024)

### Risk factors:

- Isolation and lack of contact with managers
- Poor welfare provision (for example, toilets, rest breaks, nutrition)
- Exposure to traumatic events or collisions
- Cultural issues such as bullying or exclusion
- Personal life changes (bereavement, financial stress, caregiving).

### The impact:

- Reaction time and hazard perception
- Risk assessment and decision-making
- Emotional regulation and rational responses
- Sleep quality, leading to fatigue
- Compliance with safety protocols.
